## **Halesworth Golf**

The golf club's aim is to maintain a respectable standard of dress and the highest standard of behaviour at the golf club.

### **Dress Rules**

I am sure that all members and visitors to the club would want us to maintain a respectable standard of dress. We request your help in achieving this aim.

18 Hole Blyth Course –

Gents – Trousers or Tailored Shorts, Collared Shirt, Golf Shoes

Ladies – Trousers, Cropped Trousers, Tailored Shorts or Skort, Collared Shirt, Golf Shoes

Please note, the golf shop staff will monitor and encourage those playing the 9 Hole Valley Course, who are generally just beginning the game to dress appropriately. The golf shop staff will monitor the standard of dress on both courses and if you are found on the course without the correct attire, you will be asked to leave the course.

### **Conduct Rules**

Without exception, members and visitors must always conduct themselves in a courteous, polite and considerate manner on and off the golf course at all times.

Bad and inappropriate language will not be permitted under any circumstances.

All cases of inappropriate behaviour toward fellow members, visitors or the golf club staff must be reported to the club manager

### **Mobile Phones**

The use of mobile phones is permitted but the use must not under any circumstances adversely impact on other members or visitors.

#### The use of mobile phones on the golf course

The use of mobile phones on the golf course will only be permitted in cases of emergency.

#### The use of mobile phones in the clubhouse

Mobile phones must either be switched on to silent or vibrate. If you receive a call you must withdraw to the golf club entrance to take your call.

### **Alcohol**

The sale or supply of Alcohol in the Club shall not be permitted by anyone other than the Licensee Halesworth Golf Ltd who shall be solely responsible for such sales and supply during opening hours.
